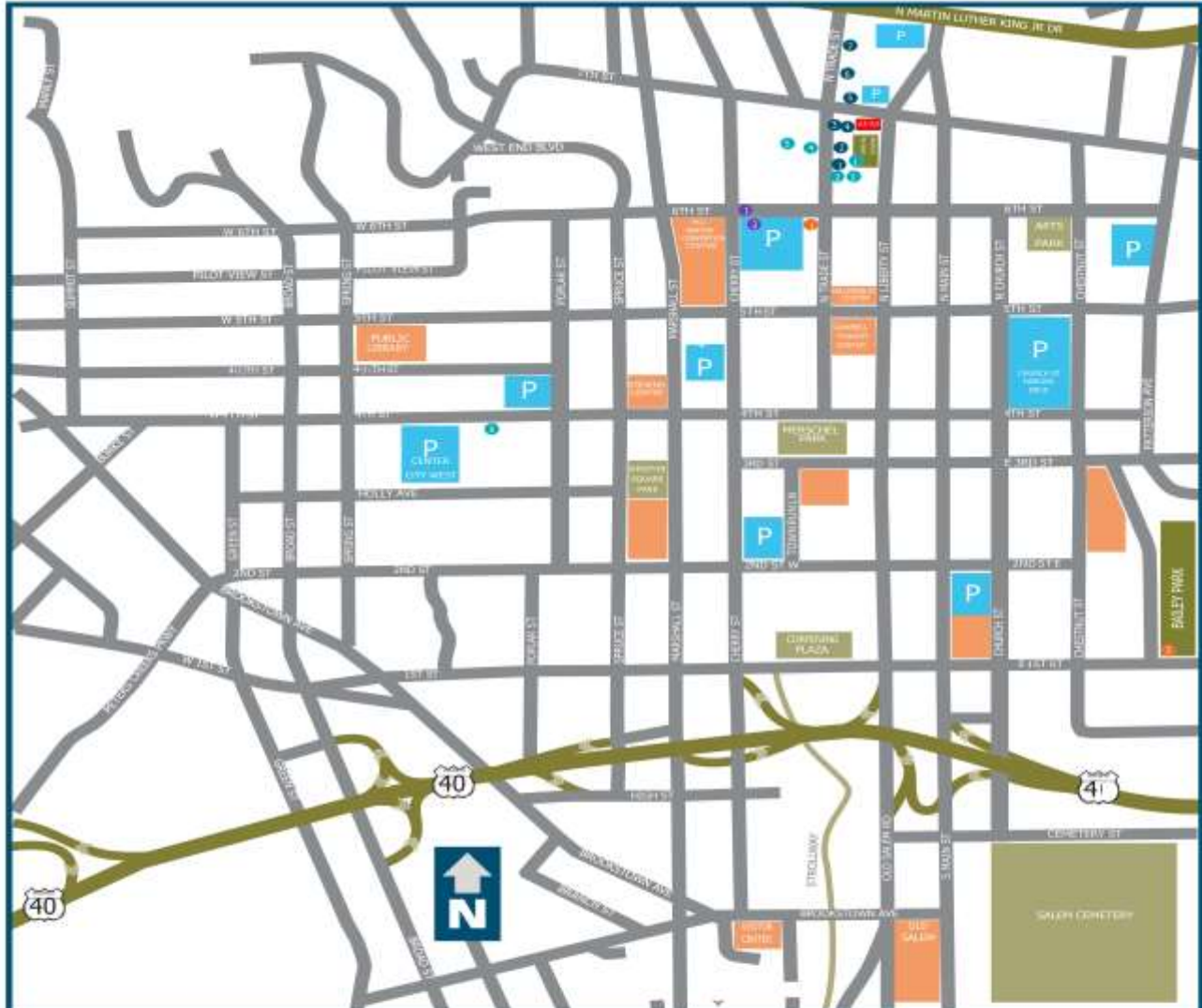


The Red Dog Gallery is open Tuesday - Friday 12 - 6, and Saturday 11 - 4
