







RED DOG GALLERY PRESENTS

"The Beauty of Words"

Sponsored by Art for Art's Sake June 4 - August 28

There is such beauty in words, how we use them to communicate our ideas, our feelings, and our emotions. Words hold power beyond their definitions. Certain words can hold special and deep meaning to people. So, for our next group exhibit at The Red Dog Gallery, we have invited artists to submit up to 3 artworks that are inspired by, visually represent, or illustrate a particular word that holds a special meaning to you as an artist and/or individual. The 3 pieces can represent different words, or the same word showing different meanings to you (showing different sides of the same coin). When submitting your work on-line you will be asked to enter 2 or 3 lines indicating the word that inspired the piece, its definition, what it means to you, and how it is interpreted in your artwork. We are allowing 3 entries per artist and placing a 500.00 limit on pricing for this show. We are encouraging smaller pieces of art with an affordable price for our patrons.

We are looking for two and three-dimensional art in all mediums and sizes. This includes, but not limited to, paintings, photography, pottery, jewelry, sculptures, etc. We would love to see lots of different mediums represented. Health regulations permitting, the reception for the "The Beauty of Words" exhibit will be held on Friday, June 4, 2021 from 6 to 8 pm. The exhibit will run June 4 to August 28, 2021. We encourage all AFAS artists to invite your friends and family, and to list the event on your Facebook page, Twitter, Instagram and website. We also have a "Shop Red Dog Gallery" page on our Website where patrons can shop the exhibit anytime from anywhere. They can email or call the gallery manager if interested in a piece. We encourage you to share this new option on your social media as well for those who are not comfortable visiting in person.

All artwork must be submitted digitally at www.theafasgroup.com, all artwork must be submitted at the same time, click on Red Dog Gallery, Submissions and follow prompts.

Eligibility: The exhibition is open to all AFAS artists.

Entry Deadline: Saturday, May 22, 2021 at midnight

Art Drop-Off: Friday, May 28 (11 am to 6 pm) and Saturday, May 29 (11 am to 4 pm)

Pick up: Saturday, August 28, 2021 (11 am to 4 pm)

Share your Knowledge + Get Paid!

Mixxer Community Makerspace is restarting their Make Stuff & Learn Stuff programs. Are you ready to emerge from your cocoon and spread your metaphorical wings? You can do that at Mixxer and get paid to share your knowledge with others who are also ready to get back out and have some fun.

Marie Mohsen, Programs Specialist, is coordinating with talented people like you to offer workshops for people to Make Stuff & Learn Stuff at Mixxer. What they are looking for is to offer opportunities to the public to learn from an Artist like you, so they can make something in wood, metal, found objects, by screen-printing, and more. Not sure if your talent is a good fit, just call or drop by and ask. Mixxer has found that folks are up for all sorts of activities if they get to make something they find interesting. Mixxer does a 50/50 split of the monies received for the instruction you will provide. Cost for materials is added to what the students are charged, and whoever supplies materials gets the money for those materials. Mixxer pays out to instructors mid-month and at the first of the month. They manage the marketing, maintaining the website and pay portal, plus providing a great space for people to meet to learn from you. All you need to bring is your skill and awesome personality, and any special things you want to show off. You don't need to be a member of Mixxer to teach or take classes, but there are discounts on class fees for Mixxer members!

Most workshops taught at Mixxer last three or four hours. Mixxer works with the instructors to help them develop the content and manages the logistics of providing a safe and suitable place for you to teach. They have a great metal shop, woodworking shop, plus indoor and outdoor spaces for all sorts of projects. There are lots of work surfaces, lighting, and electrical outlets throughout the building. Stop by for a visit to learn more and to see the different studios, and be sure to reach out to Marie to get signed up to teach stuff at Mixxer Community Makerspace.

Mixxer is located across the street from The Arts Based School, and right next door to the Winston Cup Museum at 1375 North Martin Luther King Jr. Dr., W-S, NC 27101.

Mixxer is open Tuesday – Saturday, noon to 8pm. Please call when you arrive if the gate is closed. 336.265.7362 The folks at Mixxer are looking forward to meeting you!
