Profiles of Vivid Reflections is a series of portraits of grand moments paused. The moments of intense feeling that cause us to pause and reflect in the moment rather than later in retrospect. The moments that catch us by surprise or those laden with emotion whether happy or sad, they make us feel human - and alive. Through these portraits, may the viewer create their own narrative of raw emotion portrayed. See a few examples above. This show may be seen at the Red Dog Gallery throughout September and October.

Nico Amortegui was born and raised in Bogotá, Colombia and grew up surrounded by creatives within his own family. He has lived and worked in the United States since the late '90s. Known for his large-scale paintings and murals, his public works can be found in numerous cities including Charlotte, Winston-Salem, Durham, Atlanta, DC, and Tel Aviv.

Amortegui has completed ten solo shows in four states since 2012 and dozens of group shows throughout the east coast. Most notably, you can see his work on display with the Smithsonian Latinx (*Gateways*) Collection and at the Charlotte Douglas International Airport, gates B7 & B10.

His current artistic foci include large-scale paintings on canvas or wood panels and sculpting & woodworking with found objects. He also enjoys spending time in the ceramics studio and in his elaborate garden.

He lives in Charlotte with his wife, two daughters, and studio companion - a chocolate Lab.

Pam Hoiting is a descendant of Moravian settlers in the Friedberg community of Arcadia in Davidson County, and after living much of her life in several states and even a year in Germany, has returned to the Piedmont of North Carolina.

Pam attended Western Carolina University and relocated to Atlanta Georgia after college - where she became a prominent figure in the insurance industry. She has always been interested in artistic ventures including photography, interior design, anything having to do with fabric, and most recently painting using acrylics and mixed media. Just a few years ago, she found that letting her imagination run wild and losing herself with paint brushes and canvas, was a great way to escape from the everyday stresses that we all face. She is intuitive and self-taught, and says that she rarely knows what the finished product of her work will look like. Pam usually has several pieces in various stages of completion at any given time.

Pam and her husband Tim share their home in Winston-Salem with their rescue cats Sissy and Maggie Mayhem. Maggie Mayhem-rescue cat has her own Facebook page and a line of note cards featuring photos of her in various poses. Profits from these note cards benefit animal rescue in many locations.

Pam says that from childhood she sought escape, exploration, and experience, and that emotion, intuition, passion, and vision are intertwined in her life, her soul and her art.
