The reception for the **"Summer In The City"** exhibit will be held on **Friday, June 3, 2022** from 6 to 8 pm. The exhibit will run **June 1, 2022 to August 27, 2022**. We encourage all AFAS artists to invite your friends and family to the event, as well as list the event on your Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and website pages. We also have a "Shop Red Dog Gallery" page where patrons can shop the exhibit anytime from anywhere. They can email or call the gallery manager if interested in purchasing a piece. We also encourage you to share this option on your social media and with friends and family. Please help market your work through the entirety of the exhibit.

Up to 5 pieces of original artwork per artist may be submitted on the Entry Form and **must all be submitted at the same time**. All artwork submitted must be for sale. No erotic art, propaganda, profanity or political art will be accepted. Prices cannot be increased once accepted by the curators.

Visual art in two and three-dimensional art media is eligible. This includes, but not limited to, paintings, photography, pottery, jewelry, sculptures, etc. All work must be available for sale and will have a commission of 35% attached as required by the AFAS Group.

Before submitting your work for approval, be sure to examine the show description, rules and requirements that were sent to you via email.



Getting time for our next meeting this coming Sunday at 2 at AFAS. \$5 for room use to be collected. Hope you had fun with the rivoli sunflower pendant project from last meeting. Please bring your take on the pattern. I will bring copies of my revised instructions which produced a flatter disc shape.

Sunday's project will be a long time favorite of mine, a casual reversable bracelet for men or women. It can be sparkly, matte and tribal, etc depending upon your beads. As you can see it is suitable for size 11, 8 or 6 beads. The size 8 bead version takes about 4 hours to make.

I assume that Julie will be open at 1 so you can select your beads if you need any. I will provide printed instruction (with my notes on it). As with most projects, some tweaking may be required since some 11/0s can project.
