Clifton Taylor is an artist living in Winston-Salem. An internationally recognized theatrical designer, author and lecturer, he is always interested in the subjects of Color and Light. His painting work, most often working in oil with occasional forays into other media, is usually done Plein Air. His work is most closely allied with the Cape School of Art, an American Impressionist school. He has been spending summers in Cape Cod, MA and Santa Fe, NM and spends rest of his time in Winston-Salem, where he on the faculty of the NC School of the Arts.

Mark Cole is an emerging artist who plans to dismantle your ideas of redemption and embrace social justice reform while doing so. Born and raised in Upstate New York, now a resident of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, Mark has a devotion for creation, advocacy, and accountability- which breathes life into every aspect of his art.

A succinct explanation of Mark's artistic inspiration can best be expressed in the words of the artist himself: "The creative process for me is one that is both automatic and emotional. The majority of my works are inspired by first looking at the world as a beautiful pallet of God's love. One of the "tools" that I use to express my inspiration is realized through the music I listen to - from the beat, lyrics, and emotions I feel from the music - while I am creating. For me, creating my art is like being on a roller-coaster; ups and downs, highs and lows, twists and turns. Painting for me, like life, is constant movement and constant change. The creation process is cathartic, allowing my emotions to spill out onto my canvas as a release and hopefully an inspiration to others."

Show Description and Rules

This is a call for all AFAS artists to submit your latest work for "ART on the Shelf..." a juried exhibit at Red Dog Gallery. Art can be on the wall, on a stand, hung from the ceiling or on a shelf. We encourage you to bring to life the idea of "ART on a Shelf"! That does not mean the pieces sit on a shelf. We want you to show through your art the excitement of the season for young and old alike. The idea that someone is naughty or nice. Show us the magical powers that come with the holiday season. What traditions and shenanigans are key for your family during this time of year? Where is your art vantage point for seeing the happenings of the season and keeping the mystery alive? For this group exhibit at The Red Dog Gallery we invite artists to submit up to 5 pieces of art that represent "ART on the Shelf..." for the season. We are not placing a dollar limit on pricing for this show, but we are encouraging you to consider smaller pieces of art with an affordable price for our patrons as well as what the art community can bring in this area.

The reception for the "ART on the Shelf..." exhibit will be held on Friday, November 4, 2022 from 6 to 8 pm. The exhibit will run November 1, 2022 to January 28, 2023. We encourage all AFAS artists to invite your friends and family to the event, as well as list the event on your Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and website pages. We also have a "Shop Red Dog Gallery" page where patrons can shop the exhibit anytime from anywhere. They can email or call the gallery manager if interested in purchasing a piece. We encourage you to share this option on your social media and with friends and family.

Eligibility: Open to all active AFAS artists.

Entry Deadline: Sat. Oct. 22, 2022 at midnight.

Art Drop-Off: Friday, Oct. 28 (11 am to 6 pm); Saturday, Oct. 29 (11 am to 4 pm). Please tape labels to the back of work and sign exhibition contract. Price must match what was submitted online.

Pick up: Saturday, Jan. 28, 2023 (11am to 4 pm)

Submitting Your Work Online;

All artwork must be submitted digitally at www.theafasgroup.com, all artwork must be submitted at the same time. Click on Red Dog Gallery>>Submissions>>Follow the prompts for "ART on the Shelf..."

Bio Files:

Must be less than 2MB in file size and the file name must not contain any of the special characters listed – letters and numbers only please: \sim '! @ # \$ % $^$ & * () + [] \; , / { } | \: <> ?

Digital Images:

All digital images must be .jpg or .png format, at least 72 dpi, less than 2MB in file size and the image file name must not contain any of the special characters listed above – letters and numbers only please.

Note: Images submitted for approval should not include the artist in the image, as submissions are anonymous.

Delivery/Pick-up of Accepted Art

All work should be delivered on the designated dates/times to: Red Dog Gallery 630 N. Liberty Street, W-S, NC 27101

Late work will NOT be accepted.

Works left for more than 30 days after pick-up date become the property of AFAS.
