

Raman's painting "Never give all the heart" will be on display as part of the juried exhibit "2019 Unbound and Unleashed", shown in the AFAS Red Dog Gallery, from Aug 2 to Sep 28. The painting is inspired by the poem of the same name by W.B.Yeats.

Raman's exhibition of paintings "Melting Dreams" begins on Aug 2nd, 6-7 pm at ArtsGSO office in the Cultural Centre, downtown Greensboro. The exhibition will be on display until August 30. The same evening Raman's mural "Equity and diversity in Arts" will also be unveiled at the office of ArtsGSO. This is a 55 ft long and 8 ft high mural showing 62 figures of diverse people and diverse

Raman painted a mural inside the Red Cinemas, Greensboro - caricatures of two of Bollywood's biggest stars: Amitabh Bachchan and Shahrukh Khan. Each face is about four feet tall and painted with spray paint cans. They are located near the theatre hall no. 11, where they show Hindi movies. Raman hopes it will entertain the Indian diasporas and anyone who is interested in Bollywood movies. This was spon-
