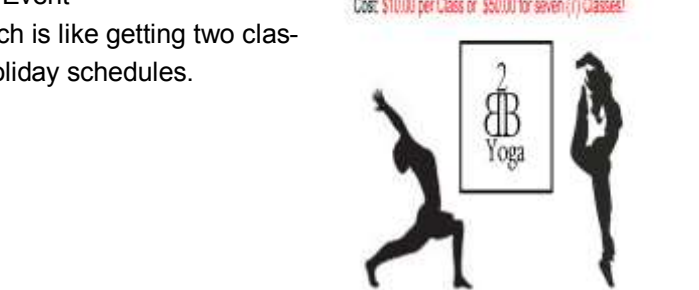
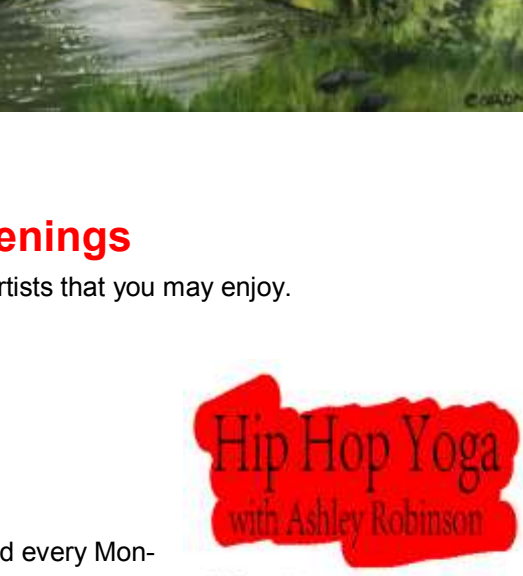
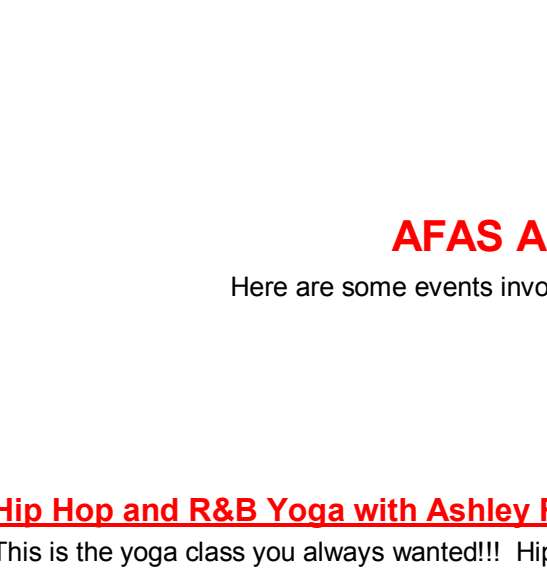
Here are 2 of our AFAS artists that we are showcasing in this newsletter.

Landreth has originals as well as prints of her mountain series available for purchase at Sunnyside Mercantile.

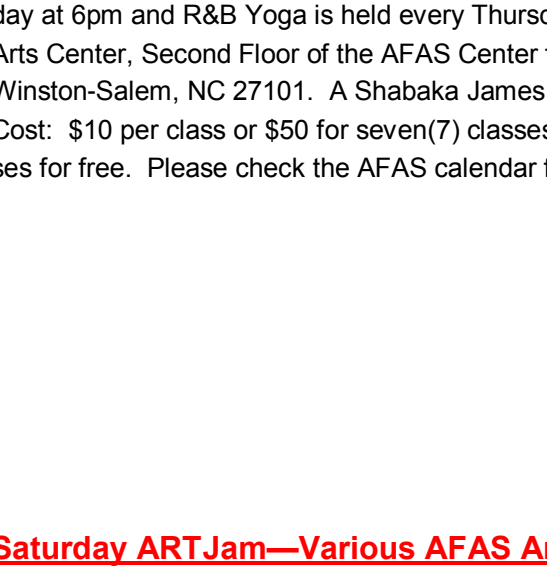
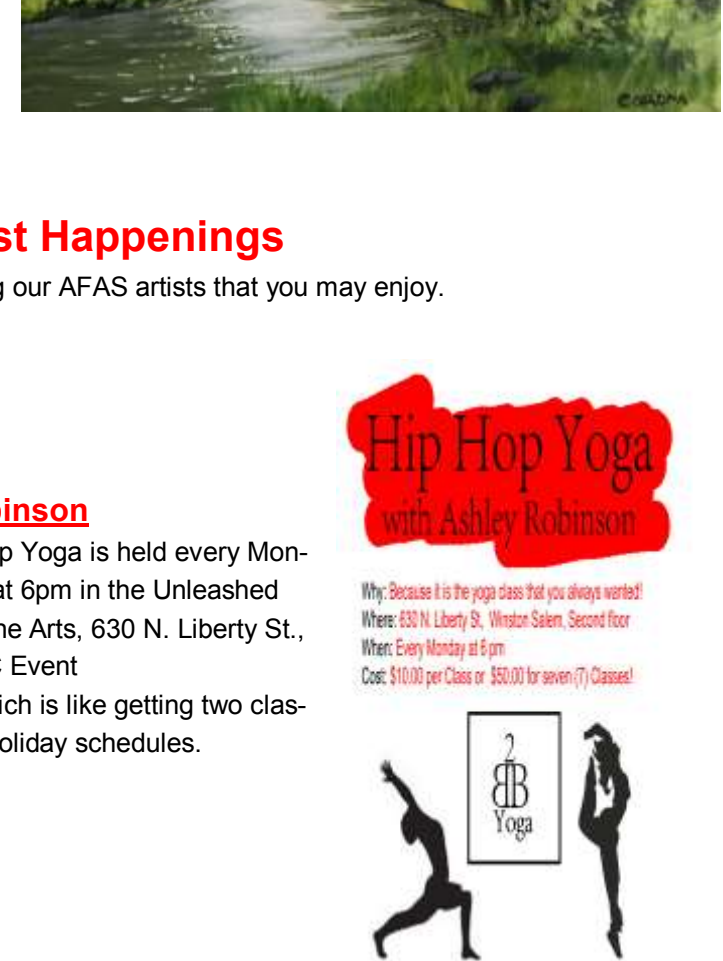


Carolina Corona

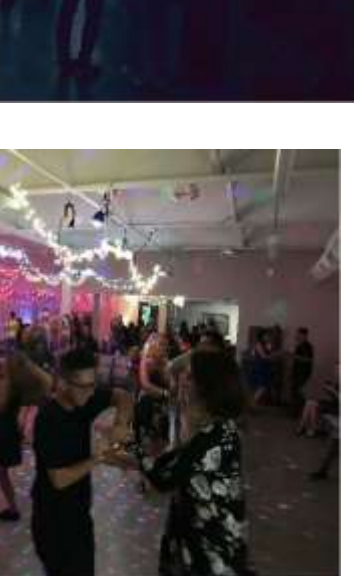


AFAS Artist Happenings

Here are some events involving our AFAS artists that you may enjoy.

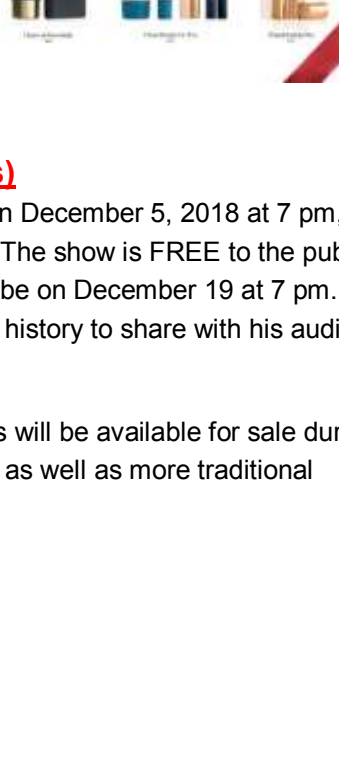
Hip Hop and R&B Yoga with Ashley Robinson

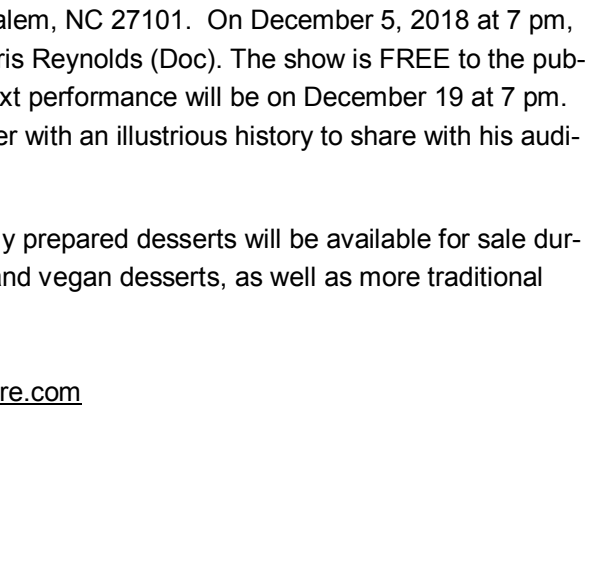
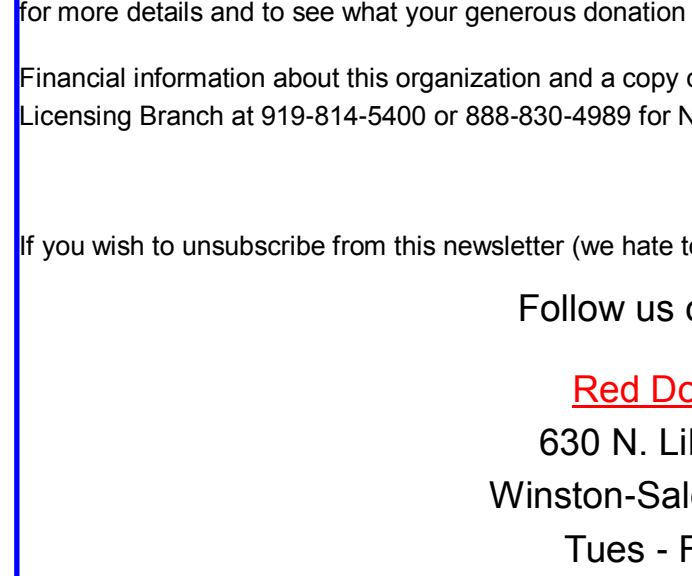
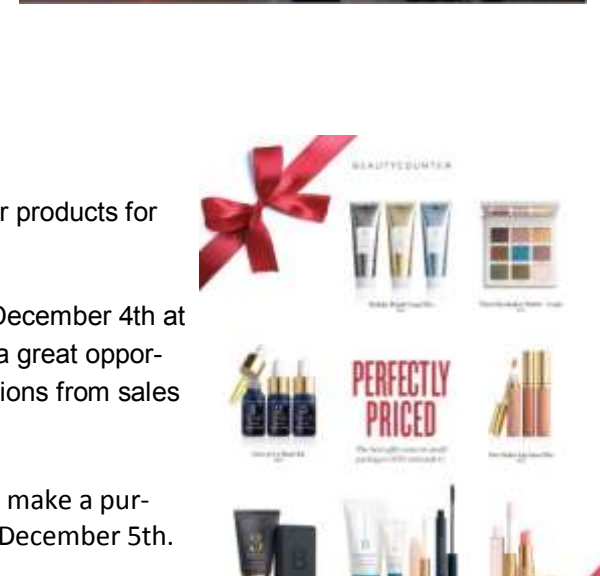

Alamance Repertory Theatre Company (ARTC Theatre Shows)

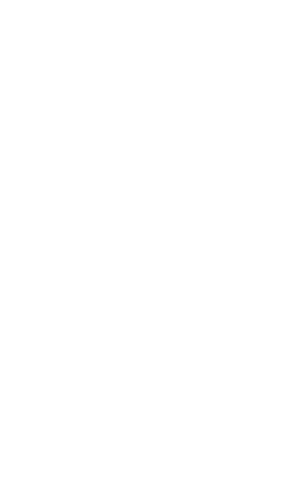

Lock Yourself Into the Arts!

Capture and lock your memory in time. Celebrate life's events from births and marriages to graduations and birthdays! Design and attach your own personal lock to the Archway in the Art District in downtown Winston-Salem on 6th street.



- Step 1: Purchase Lock**
You can purchase your lock from a local store, Saturday Art Jam event at AFAS or Arts on Sundays in September. Locks are also available for \$5.00 at: The Red Dog Gallery - 630 N. Liberty St. Studio 7 - 204 W. 6th St.
- Step 2: Prime Lock**
Prime your lock with a Outdoor primer (either spray or brush). Give your lock two coats of primer before painting.
- Step 3: Paint Lock**
Customize your lock into a one of a kind work of art with paint, permanent markers, etc.
- Step 4: Clear Coat Lock**
Applied two coats of a clear coat finish, either using a spray clear coat or brush on clear coat. This will protect your creation from the sun & weather!

Step 5: Attach lock to Archway and toss the key in the Arch base!
