Gallery Questions

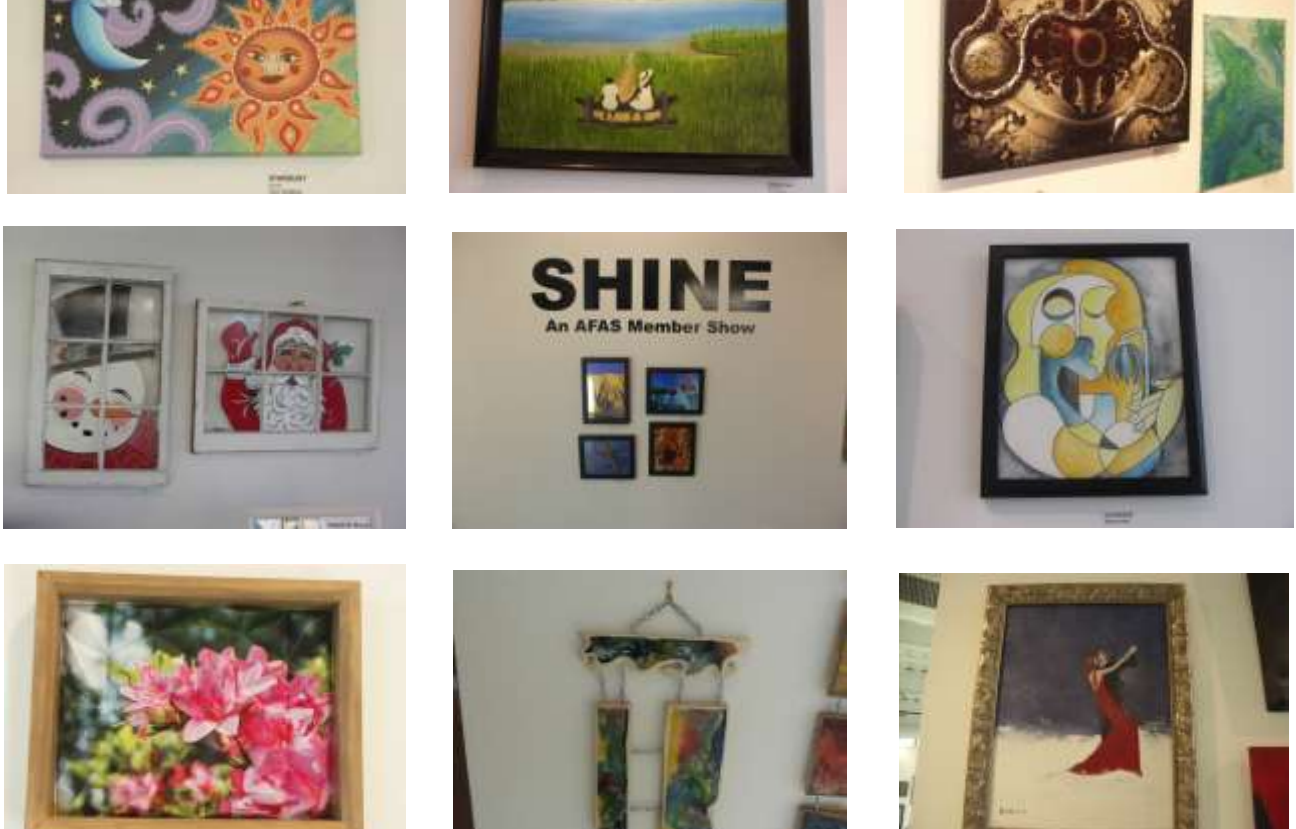

Here are 3 of our AFAS artists that we are showcasing in this newsletter.

Bob Holtje

—WoodByBob.com

Bob has been woodturning for over 15 years. His work is creative and functional. At Sawtooth School for Visual Arts he helped start their woodturning program and taught for 3 years. He is a member of the AAW, American Association of Woodturners and Treasurer of PTWA, Piedmont Triad Woodturners Association. Bob's work includes bowls, pens, wine stoppers, unique cutting boards, hollow forms, pepper mills, ice cream scoops, candle holders, beer openers, tops, ring holders, etc. He creates custom wooden pieces that are personalized and memorable for businesses, non-profits, and individuals. Most of the wood he uses is local (cherry, oak, maple, walnut, others) and imported and exotic wood from around the world. His turnings can be found at the Red Dog Gallery, Sawtooth Shop, Green Hill Center for the Arts, Southwinds Gallery, DADA, Little River Gallery and at local craft shows.



Chris Sutherland

Chris' earliest memories of art are of her painting smooth rocks that she collected with her dad from a Michigan lake, creating miniature oil paintings (which she still has!) and even building a cardboard doll house complete with upholstered cardboard furniture for her younger cousin. Drawing, doll making, fabric arts, furniture painting—she has always been involved in creative and artistic pursuits. When her daughter graduated from high school, she encouraged Chris to follow her dream, and to take formal art classes. Chris has always loved watercolors, and once she took that first watercolor class, there was no turning back! Over the years, she has studied with many nationally recognized artists including Carole Barnes, Sterling Edwards and Robert Burrigide. She sees the world as an unpredictable, beautiful, colorful and whimsical place. She paints with watercolor and acrylic paints and sometimes she adds some wild and loose pen and ink to the mix. Her 'style' is best described as contemporary and imaginative. The work of the artists of the fauvism movement, in particular Henri Matisse, has influenced her painting. She is inspired by Toulouse-Lautrec and the manner in which he depicted movement and the lively bohemian lifestyle of the 1890's. Not surprisingly, the art of Dr. Seuss has sparked her creative journey since she was three or four. Even though the world may be dark and grim at times, it is her hope that her paintings will evoke happiness, hope and maybe a little magic. Chris returned to her home state of North Carolina after residing in Virginia Beach for five wonderful years. She has a busy exhibition schedule which includes a number of juried outdoor shows each year. She is a founding member of Art Reach NC, a former exhibiting artist at The Artists Gallery in Virginia Beach, a board member of the Watercolor Society of North Carolina, and a former managing artist of Pembroke 4 Art Gallery in Virginia Beach. Her work can be found in various art galleries in the South East, at juried art shows, and gallery exhibitions



Marian Smith

Marian is retired from a long career in the Information Technology field. She has discovered that she adores art, artists, collectors of art, and almost everything associated with the creative process. She just wishes she had been born with that elusive creativity to give them!
