**Hip Hop Yoga** on Mondays and **R&B Yoga** on Thursdays.

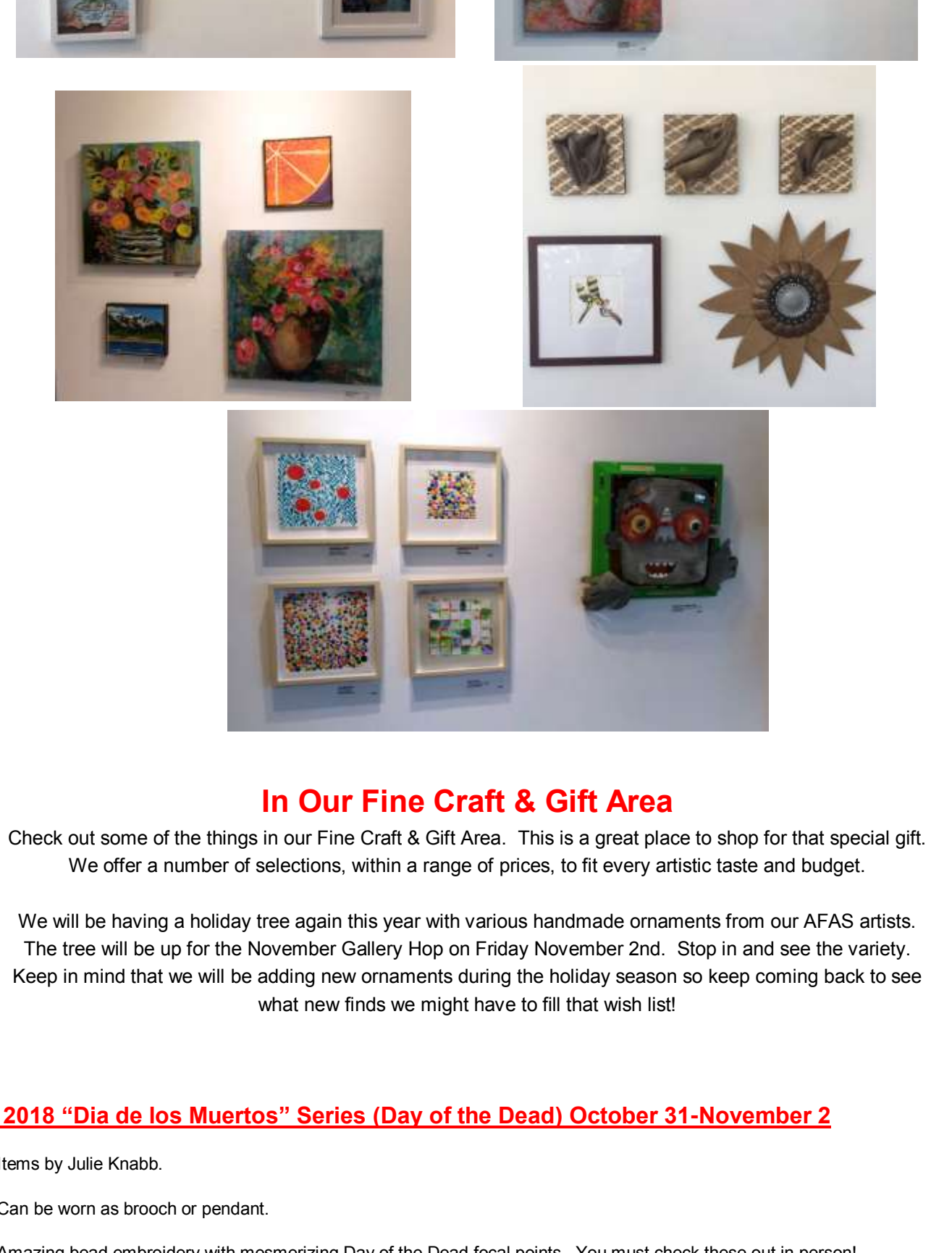

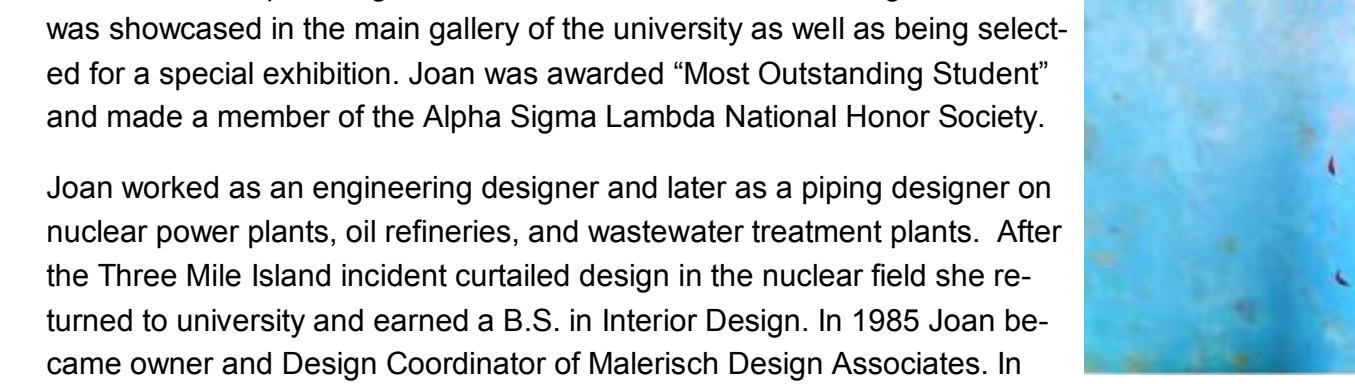

## Here are 2 of our AFAS artists that we are showcasing in this newsletter.

### Joan Fleishman

Born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Joan's interest in art began early when she majored in art in high school. She is a graduate of the Philadelphia College of Textiles & Science (Jefferson University), Bok Technical Institute and the Philadelphia Engineer's School. Her work in both design and art was showcased in the main gallery of the university as well as being selected for a special exhibition. Joan was awarded "Most Outstanding Student" and made a member of the Alpha Sigma Lambda National Honor Society.

Joan worked as an engineering designer and later as a piping designer on nuclear power plants, oil refineries, and wastewater treatment plants. After the Three Mile Island incident curtailed design in the nuclear field she returned to university and earned a B.S. in Interior Design. In 1985 Joan became owner and Design Coordinator of Malerisch Design Associates. In 1987 she was hired as the Regional Director for Instar/Hauseman where along with her staff, she managed the design and installation of numerous large commercial projects throughout the Mid-Atlantic States. Some of her client projects were Comcast, Advanta Mortgage, United States Healthcare, and Aetna Casualty.

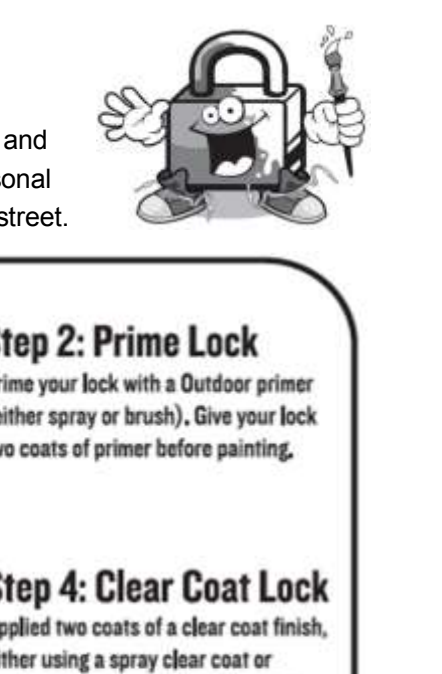
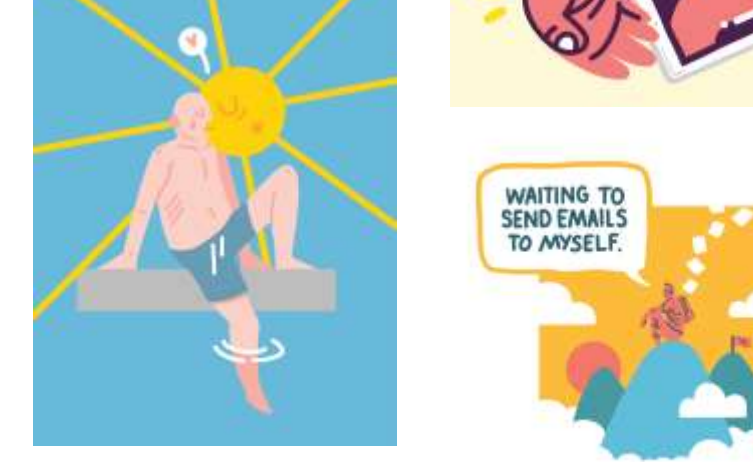
Joan fought Ovarian Cancer in the nineties and focused her time and energies on her health. During a short time in the late nineties she worked as a consultant and then directly for MRL. During this time she picked up her brush again and found a new and wonderful sense of peace through painting. In 2006 she dedicated herself to her art full time.

Her work has been shown at exhibitions and galleries in Philadelphia PA, as well as North Carolina galleries in Clemmons, Advance, Yadkinville, Mocksville, and Winston-Salem. Her works are in private collections in Philadelphia, Winston-Salem, Dresher PA, and Eugene OR. Joan's paintings have been accepted in both local and national juried shows and have won awards in 2011 and 2012. She is a member of A.F.A.S., has been a member of the Yadkin Cultural Arts Center, the Associated Artists of Winston-Salem and the Muddy River Arts Association.

She describes her technique as contemporary with an edge of abstracted realism. "I focus on my narrative of the subject. My paintings each contain a touch of realism and the extent of that touch will vary greatly. I look at each subject individually – deciding how much or how little will remain."

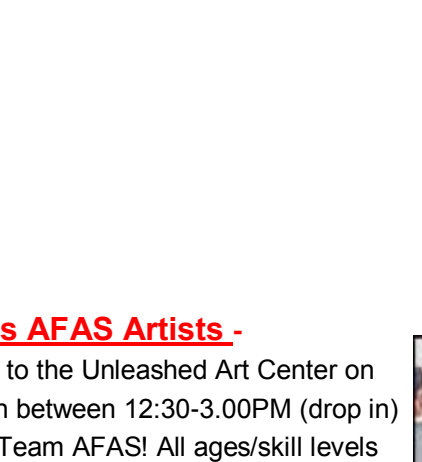
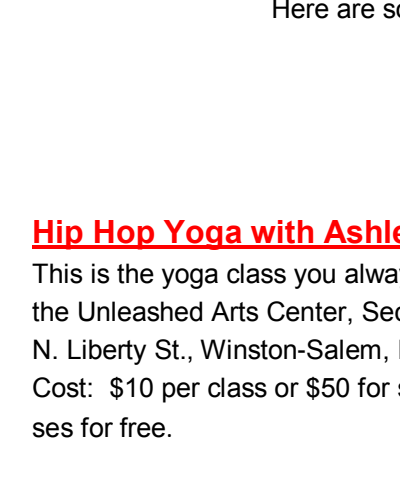

### Christian Arnder

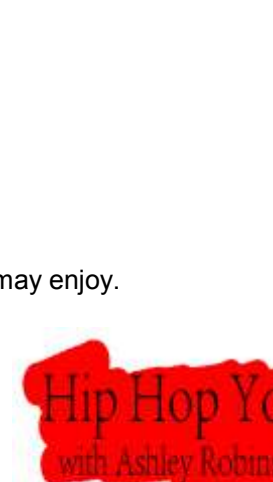

## Lock Yourself Into the Arts!

Capture and lock your memory in time. Celebrate life's events from births and marriages to graduations and birthdays! Design and attach your own personal lock to the Archway in downtown Winston-Salem on 6th street.



 <p><b>Step 1: Purchase Lock</b> You can purchase your lock from a local store, Saturday Art Jam event at AFAS or Arts on Sundays in September. Locks are also available for \$5.00 at: The Red Dog Gallery - 630 N. Liberty St. Studio 7 - 204 W. 6th St.</p>	 <p><b>Step 2: Prime Lock</b> Prime your lock with a Outdoor primer (either spray or brush). Give your lock two coats of primer before painting.</p>
 <p><b>Step 3: Paint Lock</b> Customize your lock into a one of a kind work of art with paint, permanent markers, etc.</p>	 <p><b>Step 4: Clear Coat Lock</b> Applied two coats of a clear coat finish, either using a spray clear coat or brush on clear coat. This will protect your creation from the sun &amp; weather!</p>

**Step 5: Attach lock to Archway and toss the key in the Arch base!**

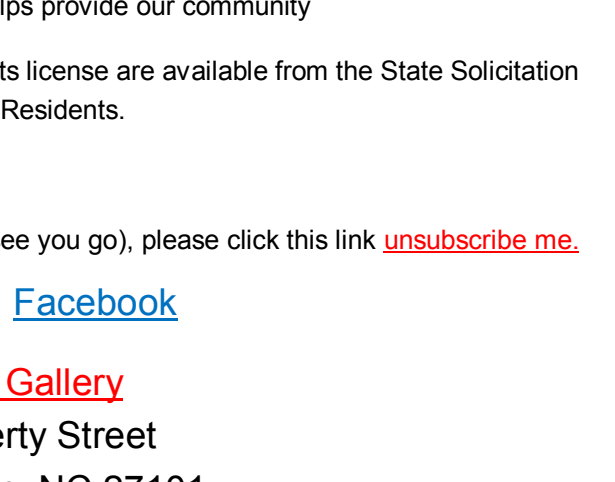
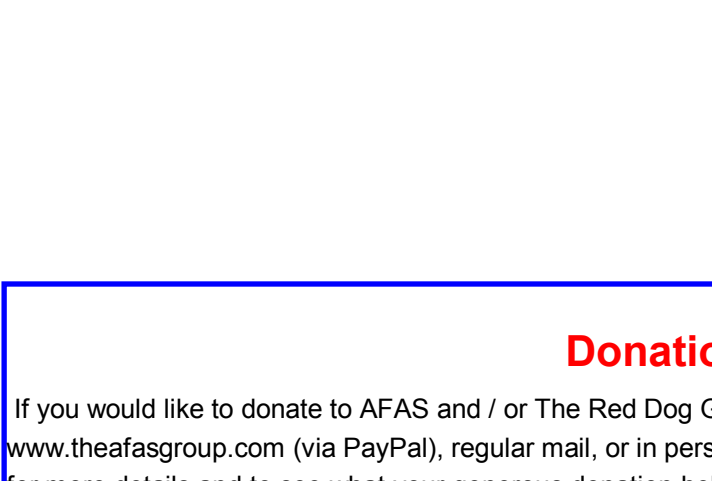
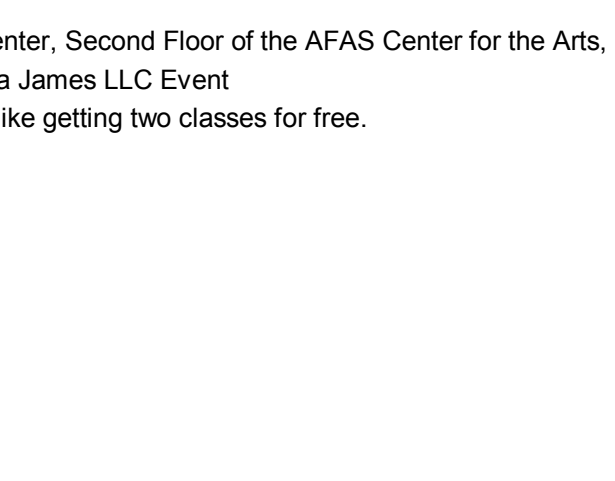
