Come to the **End of Summer Bash** on September 14th, 7-10pm on Liberty St between 6th and 7th. Enjoy some Motown Music and have some fun.

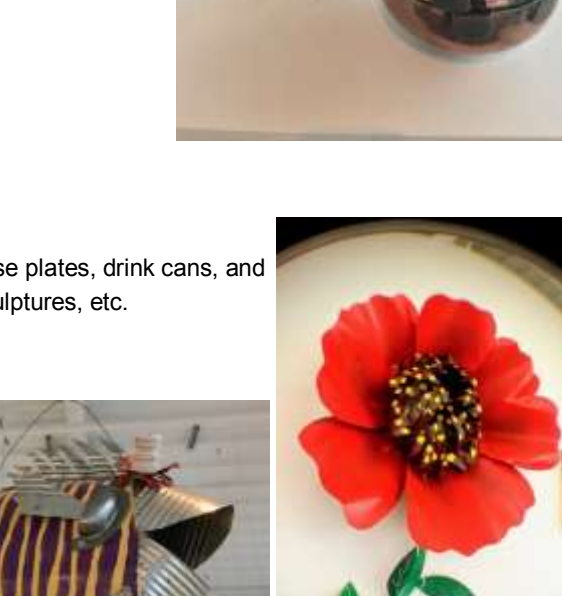
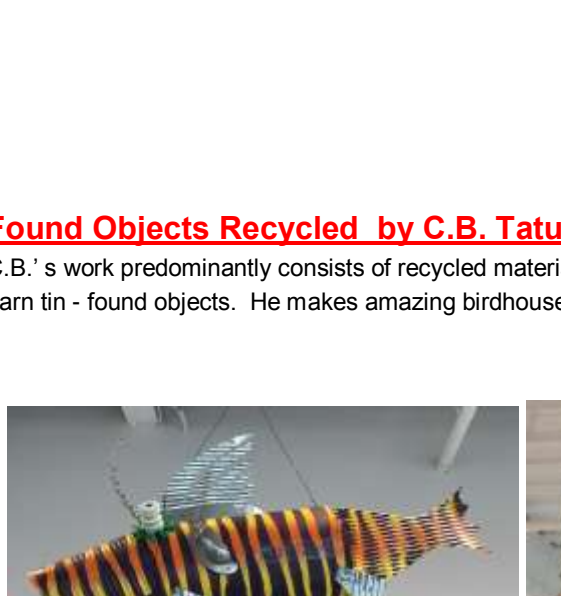
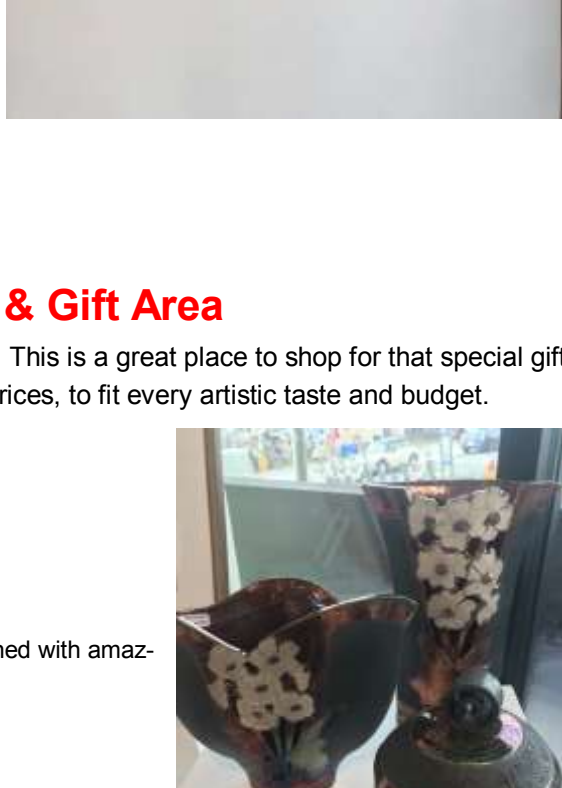
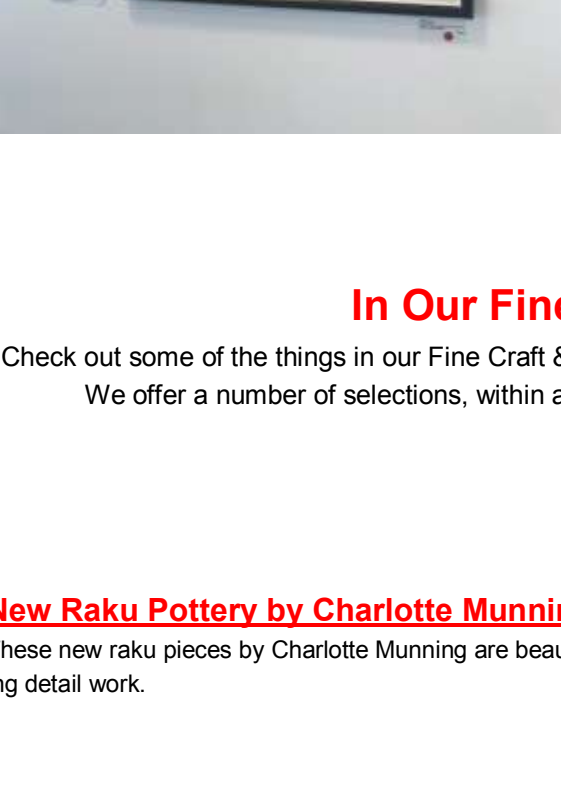

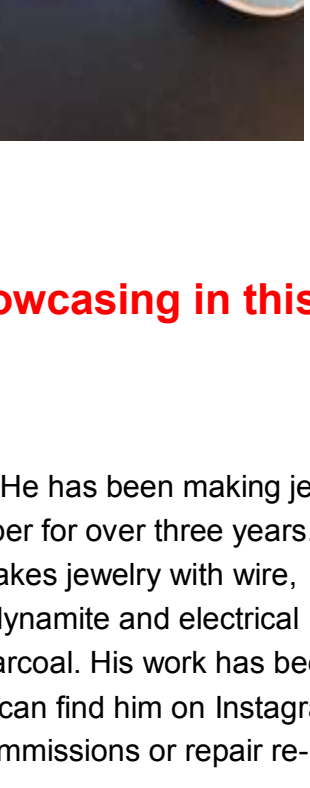
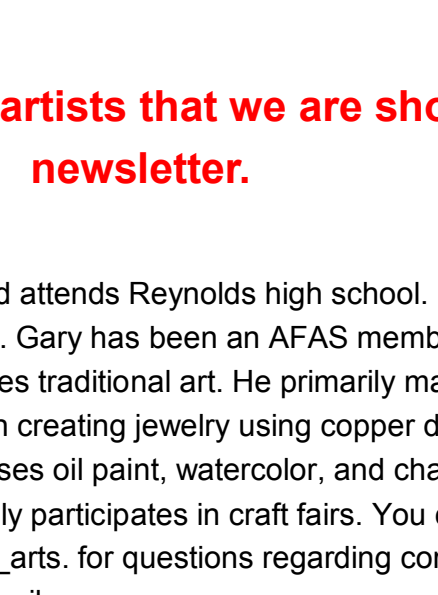
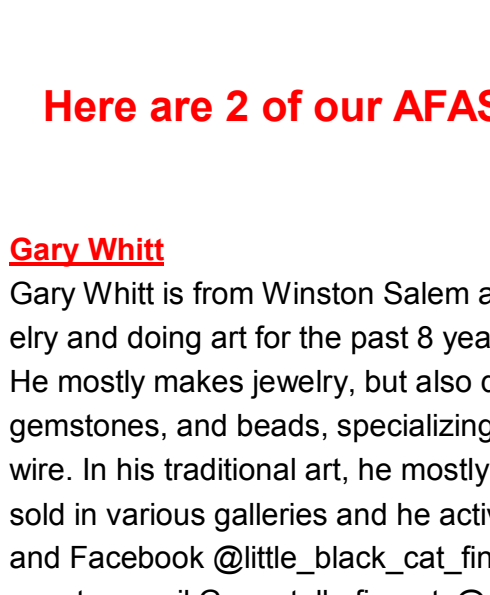
### New Raku Pottery by Charlotte Munning

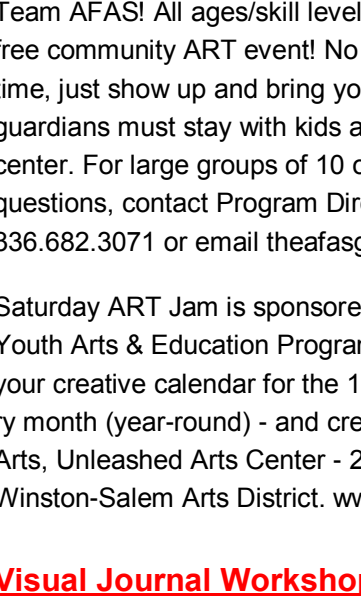
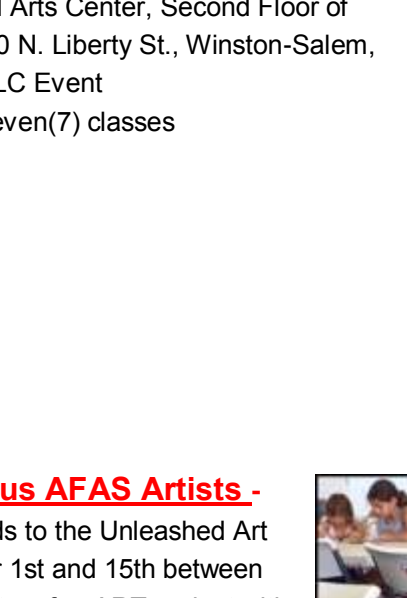
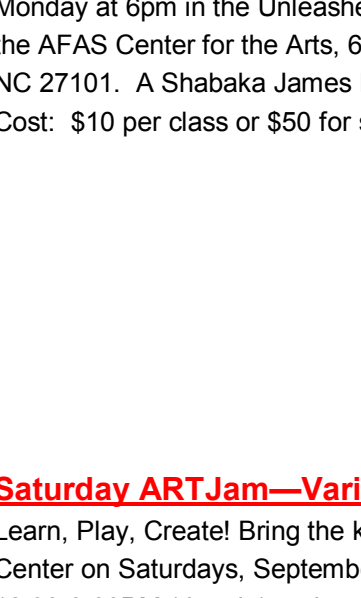


### Heather Jones

As an artist, Heather strives to bring bold colors and contrast together in a fantastical way that speak about her personal view of the world. Her paintings usually consist of female figures, silhouettes, spontaneous and often swirling movement, fun colors and striking animal images. The creative process begins subconsciously for her without a game plan, evolving in her mind after witnessing or remembering a powerful image or emotion. Then she sketches how she wants the painting to look and other additional elements in order to create her ideal composition.

Silhouettes and movement have inspired her ever since the days she spent working as a Tech. Crew member of the Drama and Theatre program at West Forsyth High School, helping to paint sets and run stage lights during performances. Several dance performances were filled with colorful light combination backdrops and perfectly posed figures before them. This excitingly caused her mind to wander and create an entirely different back story that was personal to her. She hopes to achieve the same effect for the viewer with each artwork.

Her preferred medium is acrylic paint on canvas. She strives to consistently produce beautiful artwork and build her skill set in the process. Painting has become an important part of life for Heather. She has been artistic since childhood, filling every sketchbook and journal that she could get her hands on. Although she hasn't totally given up her passion for drawing, she has a new found calling to paint that was ignited by an amazing art teacher in High School and a wonderfully supportive husband. She currently teaches traveling art classes as the instructor of Color and Coffee Painting Parties, LLC.

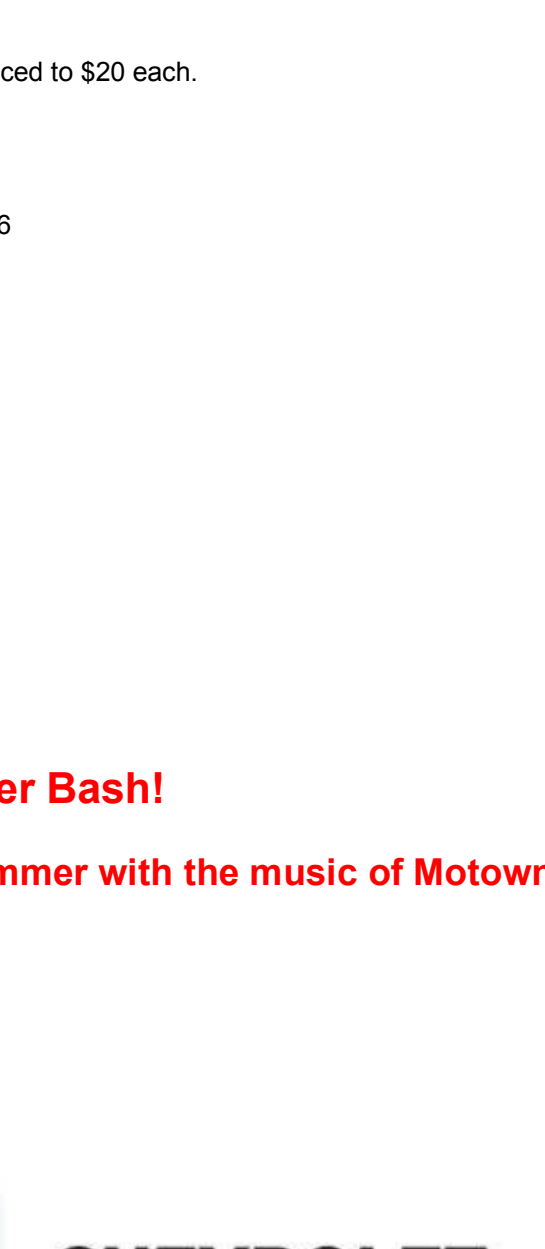

## Lock Yourself Into the Arts!

Capture and lock your memory in time. Celebrate life's events from births and marriages to graduations and birthdays! Design and attach your own personal lock to the Archway in the Art District in downtown Winston-Salem on 6th street.



**Step 1: Purchase Lock**  
You can purchase your lock from a local store, Saturday Art Jam event at AFAS or Arts on Sundays in September. Locks are also available for \$5.00 at: The Red Dog Gallery - 630 N. Liberty St. Studio 7 - 204 W. 6th St.

**Step 2: Prime Lock**  
Prime your lock with a **Outdoor primer** (either spray or brush). Give your lock two coats of primer before painting.

**Step 3: Paint Lock**  
Customize your lock with a paint of a kind work of art with paint, permanent markers, etc.

**Step 4: Clear Coat Lock**  
Applied two coats of a clear coat finish, either using a spray clear coat or brush on clear coat. This will protect your creation from the sun & weather!

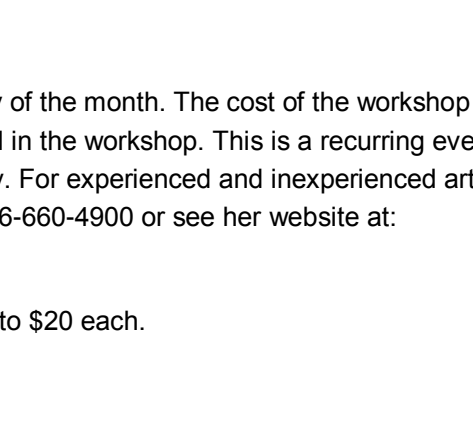
Step 5: Attach lock to Archway and toss the key in the Arch base!

Here are some events involving our AFAS artists that you may enjoy.

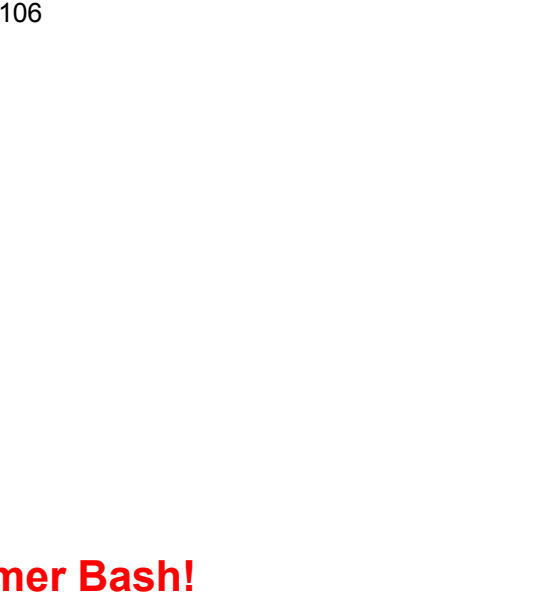
### Hip Hop Yoga with Ashley Robinson
