Rules & Requirements

Contest is open to students in middle and high school who live in Forsyth County, N.C. during the 2013 – 2014 school year. Only original visual artwork in color is accepted including: print, drawing, painting, collage, photo, or computer-generated artwork. Submission must relate to the theme of books, reading and/or writing and must be submitted on the official contest template. Artwork must be flat and may not include three-dimension. Printed bookmark will be approximately 3 X 9 inches. The artist's name must not appear on the artwork. One entry per artist.

Please include the following on a separate sheet with template submission: Name, mailing address, e-mail, phone, school, grade, age *plus* phone/e-mail for parent
