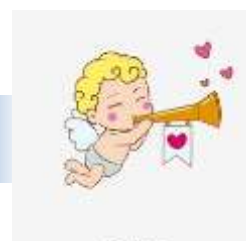

- Halloween masks, patterned pumpkins, witches, ghosts, brooms, witch hats

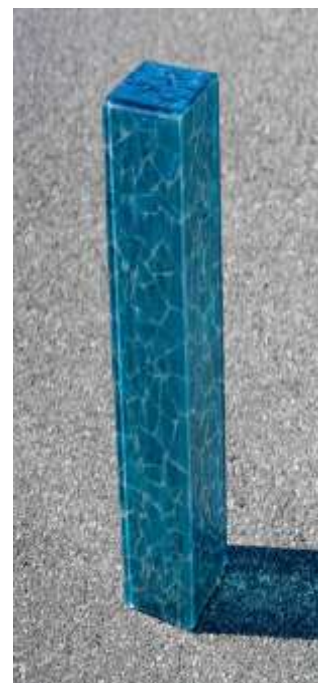

AFAS Ribbons Ashcan Project

AFAS would like to install an ashcan behind the Ribbons structure in the ARTivity on the Green Park. It would receive cigarette butts and trash from people sitting in the Ribbons. We'd like your ideas of what it should look like and how it should be built.

Option 1 would be anything that you can think of, working with these ideals:

It needs to be weather and vandal resistant.

It needs to be mountable so that somebody cannot easily take it, but still have a way to be emptied.

It needs to accept cigarette butts that may not be fully snuffed out (does not easily catch fire).

It should look presentable, to fit the AFAS artistic intent of the park.

Option 2 – repurpose a trash can that has already been removed from the park. We have a beat up can that could be repaired and modified. Please see the pictures below. Its current specifications are:

15” in diameter, 39” tall (not including a chunk of concrete on its bottom).

Has a cylinder-shaped plastic insert that snugly fits inside, and is 28 1/2” tall

The metal (outside) of the can has holes in the bottom. The insert has a solid bottom.

Most of the outside metal is perforated. The insert is solid.

There are two large openings in the sides of the metal can that are about 29” above the bottom. The plastic insert does not cover those openings (when inserted), but the insert does have two openings itself (near the top) that are hand grabs (to allow one to lift it out to empty it).

The metal can is dented and squashed out-of-round. Its side seem is split about halfway along its length. The original top is missing. There are stickers and graffiti all over it. All of this can be redone as part of its redesign.
