Art at the Heart at AFAS — an after school art program every Tuesday from 4 to 5:30pm.

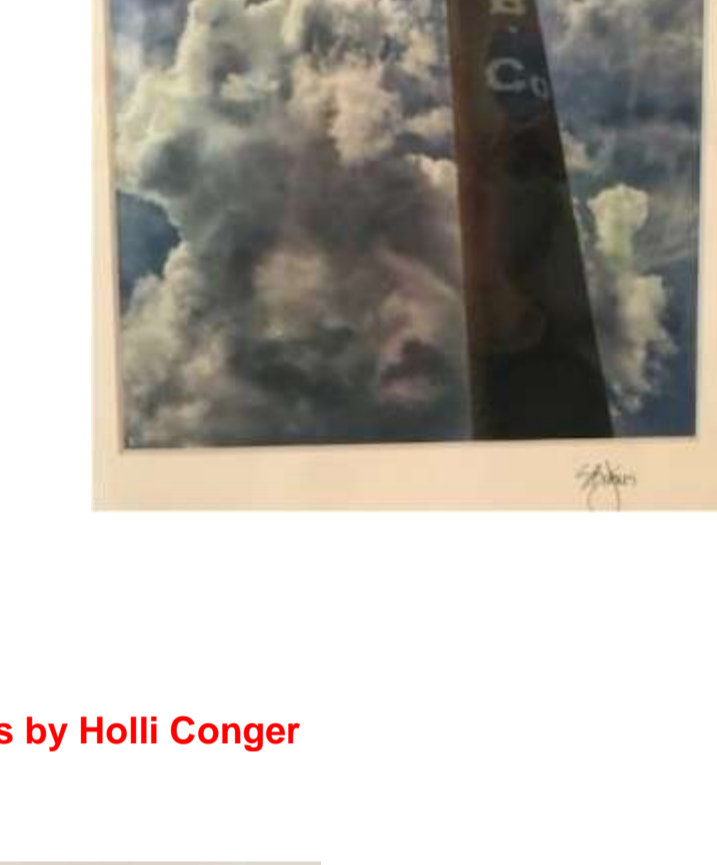
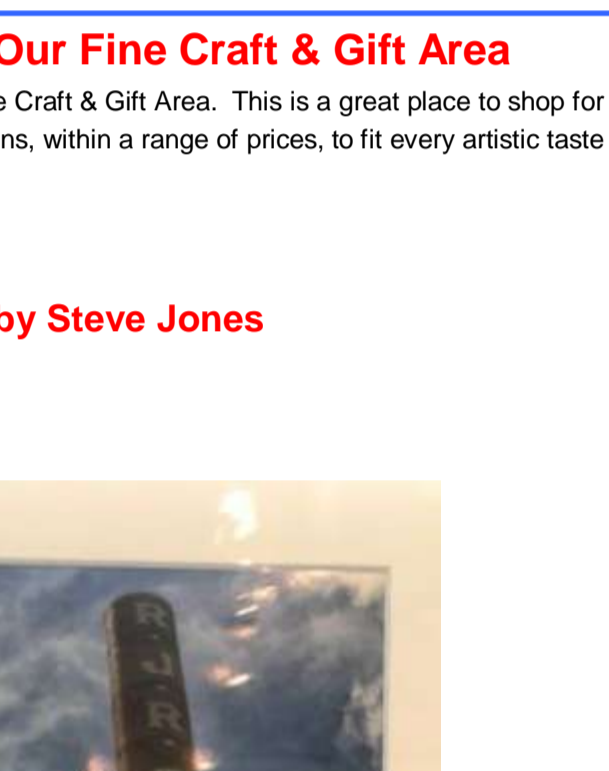

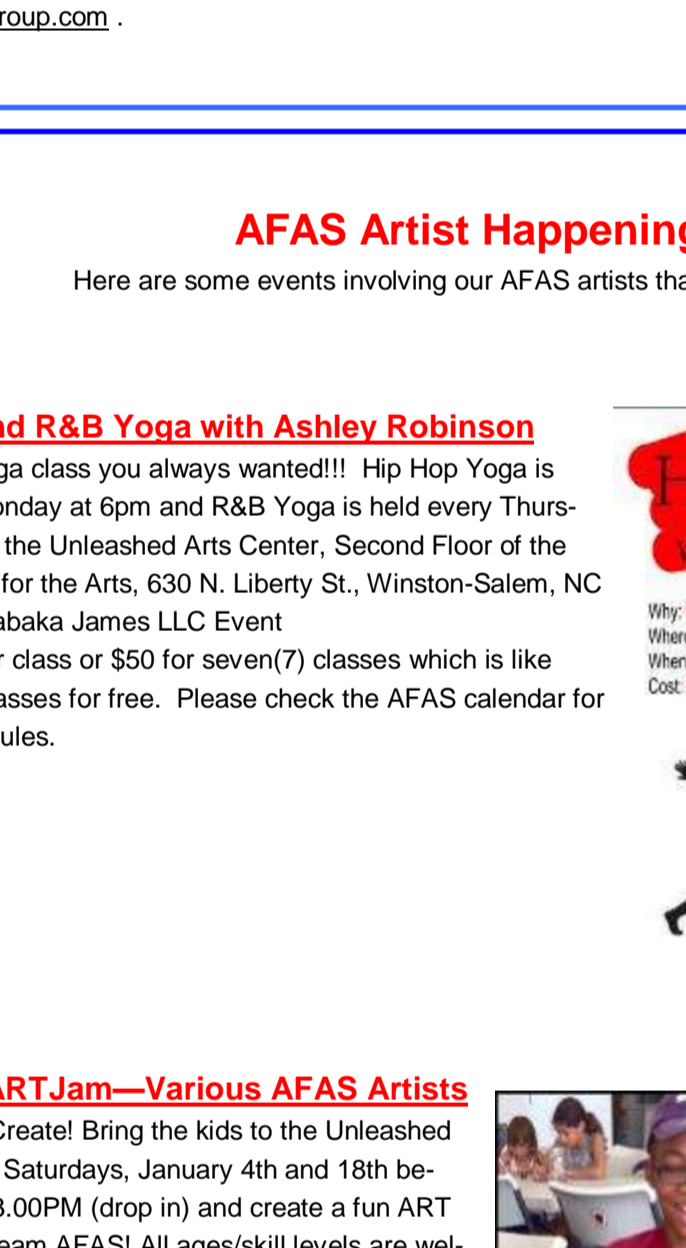
Come out during Gallery Hop, on Friday January 3rd (limited hours) and see the show.



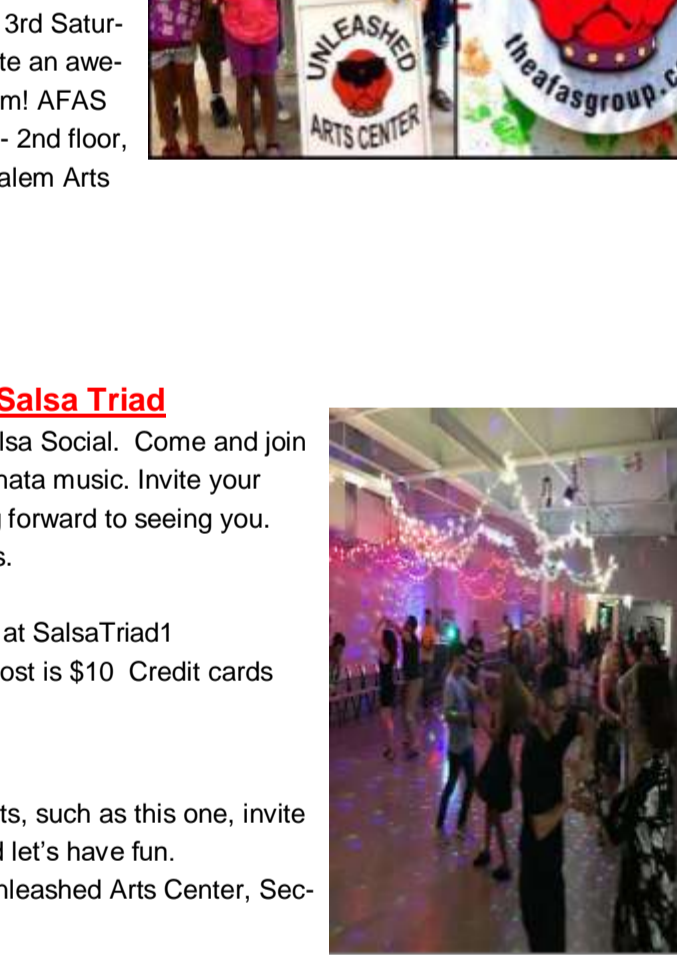
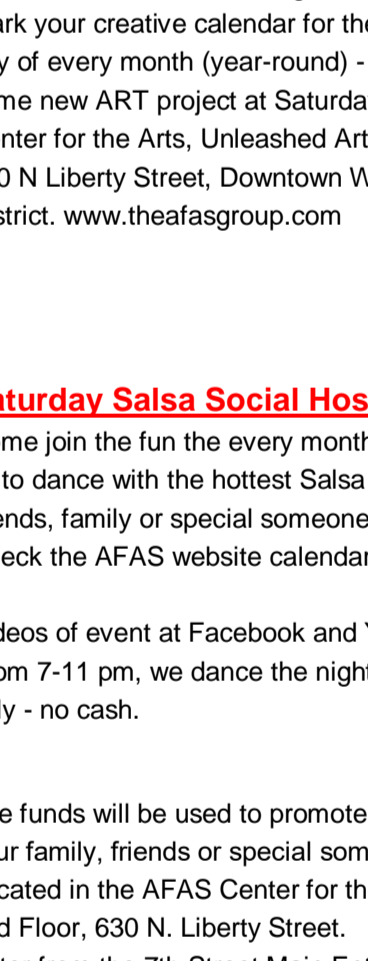

Cost: \$10 per class or \$50 for seven(7) classes which is like getting two classes for free. Please check the AFAS calendar for holiday schedules.



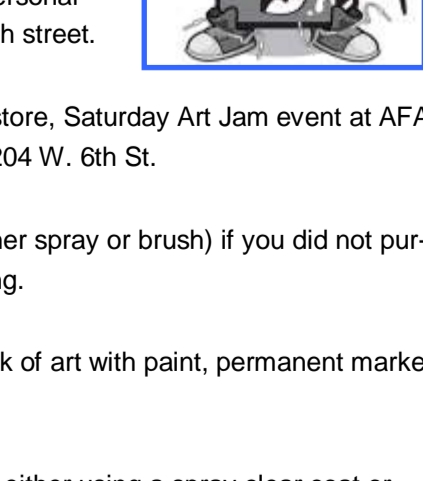
#### Saturday ARTJam—Various AFAS Artists

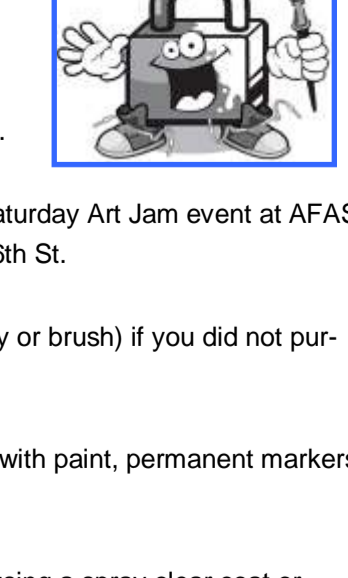
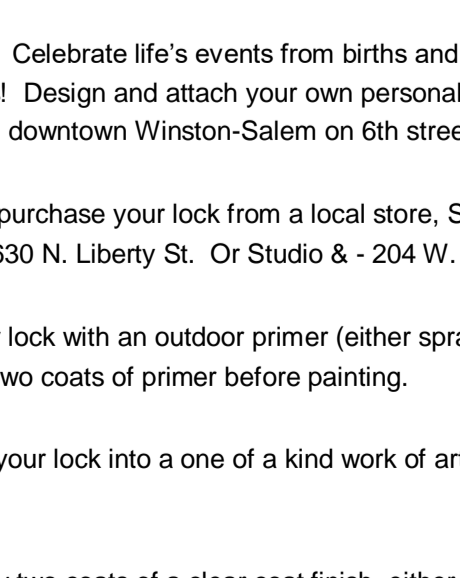
#### Preschool Art Exploration

### Lock Yourself Into the Arts!

Capture and lock your memory in time. Celebrate life's events from births and marriages to graduations and birthdays! Design and attach your own personal lock to the Archway in the Art District in downtown Winston-Salem on 6th street.



**Step 1: Purchase Lock** You can purchase your lock from a local store, Saturday Art Jam event at AFAS or for \$5.00 at The Red Dog Gallery—630 N. Liberty St. Or Studio & - 204 W. 6th St.

**Step 2: Prime Lock** —Prime your lock with an outdoor primer (either spray or brush) if you did not purchase already primed. Give your lock two coats of primer before painting.

**Step 3: Paint Lock** —Customize your lock into a one of a kind work of art with paint, permanent markers, etc.

**Step 4: Clear Coat Lock** —Apply two coats of a clear coat finish, either using a spray clear coat or brush on clear coat. This will protect your creation from the sun & weather.

**Step 5: Attach lock to Archway to the Arts and toss the key in the Arch base!**
